

New Leaf Society add fall blooms to city streets



Forty flats of annual plants, including snapdragons, pansies and dusty miller, were donated to the City of Mebane by the New Leaf Society. Their beautification crew changes the baskets and containers around town, and this season added fall plants. Other contributions by the New Leaf Society to Mebane include funding for the sculpture garden at the Mebane Historical and Train Museum, the planters in Historic Downtown, a natural playground at Holt Street Park, and the planting of new street trees.
